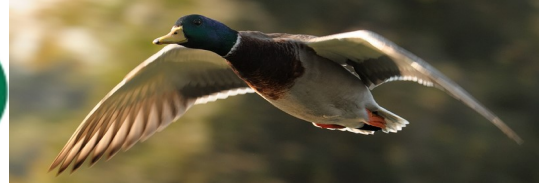
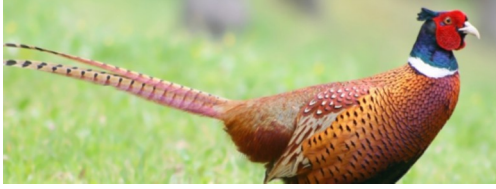


November 3, 2019 – Member & Youth Wingshoot and Cookout



Kick off the Fall shooting season with a special Member & Youth Wingshoot and Cookout on Sunday, November 3rd at the TMT Hunting Preserve in New York's scenic Hudson Valley. DSC Northeast has reserved the preserve for the entire day for sole use of our Chapter members and their guests, with a special focus on introducing new Youth hunters to the outdoors lifestyle. Choose from upland shooting for pheasant & chukar, mallard ducks over decoys, or both!. Shoot a half day or the entire day, and gather for a hearty meal over the grill in the crisp Fall weather. A great event to share some camaraderie, shake the cobwebs off your field shooting, and put some fine-eating in your freezer!

Main Event Details:

- **Date:** Sunday, November 3, 2019 (Rain or Shine)
- **Location:** TMT Hunting Preserve, 302 Schoolhouse Rd., Staatsburg, NY 12580

- **Day's Schedule:**
 - **Morning Shoot (Choice of Pheasant/Chukar or Mallards):** 9 AM – 12 Noon (please arrive NLT 8:30 AM for required pre-shoot briefing)
 - **Lunch:** 12 Noon – 1 PM. Hamburgers & Grilled Italian Sausages; BYOB (no alcohol for those who will be shooting in the afternoon, please)
 - **Afternoon Shoot (Choice of Pheasant/Chukar or Mallards):** 1 PM – 4 PM (please arrive NLT 12:30 PM for required pre-shoot briefing)
 - **Dinner:** 4-5 PM. Choice of Steak Tips, Pork Chop or BBQ Chicken; BYOB
- **Lodging:** For those desiring overnight lodging, numerous options exist in the nearby towns of Kingston and Rhinebeck (each town also offering tourism options for those traveling with family)
- **Pricing / Other Admin:**
 - **Pheasant/Chukar:** Half-day combo hunt for pheasant/chukar (5 released pheasants or 6 released chukars per shooter, or any equal value combination thereof) with guide and dog priced at **\$275/person** for each group of 2 persons min. – 4 persons max. Recommend 2 3/4" game loads in no lighter than #6 shot for pheasant as the ringnecks here are all big, strong fliers.
 - **Mallards:** Half-day hunt for mallards (5 released mallards per shooter) from blind over decoys with guide and dog priced at **\$250/person** for each group of 2 persons min. – 6 persons max. Non-toxic shot required for all duck shooting (recommend two boxes per shooter of #2, #3, or #4 shot, either 2 3/4" or 3" magnum; #3 steel shot with modified choke is ideal as ducks will mainly present longer pass-shooting type shots). Shotguns used for ducks must be "plugged" to prevent them from firing more than 3 rounds before reloading.
 - **Misc:** Extra birds may be added at cost. Hunters may take their own complete birds "as is" for self-processing, or may swap them for shrink-wrapped/frozen breasts at \$6/each.

- **Hunting Licenses:** Not required for Preserve hunts.
- **Clothing/Protection:** Fluorescent Orange hats & vests required for all upland hunters. Camo or dark colored clothing recommended for waterfowl hunters. Eye and hearing protection must be worn by all shooters at all times..

Special Notes for Youth Hunters:

- **Age Requirement:** For all Youth hunters, 12 years minimum age
- **Legal Release:** All Youth hunters will need to have a release form signed by parent or other legal adult guardian prior to being allowed afield
- **Training:** It is highly recommended (but not required) that all Youth hunters have completed a Hunter Safety Course. At a minimum, all youth hunters should have had some basic training in safe gun handling. Depending on the actual experience levels of attendees, the preserve may conduct a short (<1 hr) gun handling/hunting lesson for Youth attendees prior to allowing them afield.
- **Restriction:** First time/unexperienced Youth hunters will be limited to waterfowl versus upland shooting. Reasons for this are: 1) Safety (youth shooters in static position inside the duck blind are more easily supervised for safety), 2) Shooting Opportunities (youth will likely get more shots each in the duck blind than in upland hunting), and 3) Numbers (as the duck blind can accommodate up to 6 shooters -- 3 groups of 2 – waterfowl shooting provides the opportunity to expose a greater number of new hunters to the sport). Youth hunters will only be allowed to participate in upland shooting for pheasant/chukar if they have valid Hunter Safety Certification and have also had prior experience shooting over dogs.
- **Youth Loaner Equipment:** As DSC Northeast is aware that new hunters may not have all their own equipment, we are working to arrange for availability of suitable youth loaner guns if needed. If you will require use of a youth loaner gun please notify us as far in advance of event as possible to guarantee availability. While there would be no charge for use of youth loaner gun, users will be required to pay for their own ammo (available for purchase onsite). Youth eye & hearing protection will be provided at no charge.
- **Youth Discount:** To encourage introduction of youth to the hunting & outdoors lifestyle, DSC Northeast will be subsidizing costs of all youth hunters at 50% off standard rates as published above.
